6. What are we saying about ourselves and our judgment when we make judgments where God has not?

Jot down at least four principles that come out of these verses that will cause you to be pleasing to God and approved by people. Pray that God will give you a renewed passion for serving Christ in this way

An Important definition

The three facets of legalism

- Using rules, standards, or associations as a way to get to God
- 2. Getting to God by faith but achieving holiness or sanctification submitting to certain rules, disciplines, standards and associations
- 3. Elevating human preferences, philosophies, politics, and standards and infusing them with a standard of biblical absolutes.

Legalism is always someone else's sin

What you're turning back from (Galatians 3:1-9)

Why they were so susceptible

Their problem was that they just forgot their roots

They were trying to achieve what they already had

- 1. The righteous person shall live by faith!
- 2. They wanted to be like Abraham when they already were!
- 3. They wanted to have God's blessing when they already had it!

What you're turning back to (Galatians 3:10-14)

From blessing to curse

From right living to wrong living – even though it looks so good!

The great turnaround – Redeemed so that Abraham's blessing becomes our blessing.

Getting to know you
