1 Samuel 1 – 2:10

Waiting on God in times of affliction leads to our understanding of his purposes, hope in his patience, excitement for his provision, and joy in his worship.

We wait on God to prepare us for his will. (1 Samuel 1:3-8)

We wait on God who is waiting for us. (1 Samuel 1:9-11)

We wait on God to provide his promises. (1 Samuel 1:12-18)

We wait on God to perfect our praise. (1 Samuel 1:24 – 2:10)

Salvation is the solution for all things. (2:1)

God is distinguished from all things. (2:2)

God is the standard by which all things are weighed. (2:3)

The powerless and disadvantage are God's concern. (2:4-5)

God alone has authority over life and death. (2:6)

In God, one's status is not fixed or unchangeable. (2:7-8)

God alone is the judge of all things. (2:9-10)
