How can we truly make scripture relevant to life?

Pay attention to it (2 Peter 1:12-21; Hebrews 5:12)

Peter is giving his people his <u>final challenges</u>; every word counts!

Remain faithful to it (2 Timothy 3:14-17; Hebrews 5:12)

It isn't enough to have a great start. You've got to stay faithful. Scripture makes you wise for salvation: for saving and growing.

The challenge given to Timothy is to <u>listen to scripture's</u> message; not just to speak them.

## Listen to it and do it (James 1:19-25)

A <u>window</u> looks out at others; a <u>mirror</u> looks back at yourself.

The purpose of the mirror is to <u>affirm</u> and <u>correct</u>.

### Integrate it into everything (Deuteronomy 6:6-8)

Professing without possessing will always be catastrophic.

#### PSALM 119 (NIV)

<sup>9</sup> How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to your word.

<sup>11</sup> I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. <sup>12</sup> Praise be to you, LORD; teach me your decrees.

<sup>28</sup> My soul is weary with sorrow; strengthen me according to your word. <sup>29</sup> Keep me from deceitful ways; be gracious to me and teach me your law.

<sup>33</sup> Teach me, LORD, the way of your decrees, that I may follow it to the end. <sup>34</sup> Give me understanding, so that I may keep your law and obey it with all my heart.

<sup>59</sup> I have considered my ways and have turned my steps to your statutes. <sup>60</sup> I will hasten and not delay to obey your commands.
