#### Getting to Know You

1. John's message included a reminder that the Bible is a story or narrative not a textbook for school. What are your top two favorite bible stories to remember?

#### Into the Bible

2. Read Mark 5:21-43, this passage offers many parallels to the one we studied on Sunday in John's gospel. What states of being would you prescribe to the two primary individuals, the father and woman, based on this passage?

Verses 25-28 outline the woman's past, present, and future hope. Should we take the woman's past as evidence for the insufficiency of modern medicine and/or as evidence of humanities often ineffective self-reliance? Why did you settle on your answer, can you support it up with any other biblical references?

Mark shares with us that both Jairus (Vrs. 35) and the woman (Vrs. 33) have moments of doubt or fear. How does Jesus' identical response of belief/faith quell the fear they are facing?

3.	John spoke of Jesus' response to the official in John 4:48 as a rebuke, but
	also as an invitation for him to want something more than just a sign. What
	could possibly be better than witnessing or being the recipient of a powerful
	miracle?

#### **Application**

4. God's perspective, pace, and plan are often drastically different than ours and certainly "messier" than we would like. How has God already shown you in your recent or distant past that his perspective, pace, and plan are trustworthy for what is taking place today? Share with your group your story and how it applies to what is currently going on in your life.

5. The royal official walked 25 miles to get to Jesus because he no options left. What is your "25 mile" walk or, hurdle, that you can begin to overcome to find the lasting joy Jesus promises? What are your first action steps to practice?
