Getting to Know You

1. Share a time when you have been in a crowd about the size of the one in this miracle. Do you think the people in the back even knew a miracle was taking place?

Into the Bible

2. The two miracles in John 6 had no lasting physical results. The people woke up hungry the next day and had to eat the ordinary way. Jesus stepped into the boat and rode to shore with the disciples. So, if we miss the spiritual meaning, we miss everything important. Read Numbers 11:4-9. How is the grumbling of the Israelites similar to the grumbling of the Jews in John 6?

3. Peter said in John 6:68, "You have the words of eternal life." Yet many of his earliest disciples walked away when they heard the hard words that Jesus said. Read 2 Corinthians 15-16. How can the aroma of Christ that we carry be the aroma of death for some and life for others?

Application

4. All the application questions for this series on John have been similar. That's because the signs all focus on John's purpose: to move beyond the miracle to belief in the one who did the miracle. What can you point to in your life to show that you are more interested in the bread-giver than in the bread?

5. Eternal life is more than life without end that we look forward to in the future. It is also the abundant life that we have with Christ now. Encourage your group by sharing something God is doing in your life now that is characteristic of eternal life.
