Getting to Know You

2. Read Luke 5:1-11. This is one of the gospel passages that deals with the calling of some of the disciples. What elements of discipleship do we see here? (Authority, obedience, sacrifice) What was the practical cost to those men of following Jesus, both in that moment and throughout their lives? Why was it worth it?

3. Read Ephesians 4:1-16. What character traits are given in those opening verses and how do they relate to discipleship? According to Paul, what is the goal of spiritual gifting and discipleship in the church?

4. John gave two examples of discipleship done right to open his sermon. What characteristics were common to Aquila & Priscilla as well as Timothy that made them effective disciples? How can we cultivate those same qualities so that we too might be effective disciples?
