## Getting to Know You

1. What is your favorite song that speaks of heaven or reminds you of heaven?

#### Into the Bible

2. Some people have argued that God's promise to wipe away all tears (Revelation 21:7) logically requires that our memories be erased because of the taint of sin and pain that attaches to all of our earthly life. Will we lose our sense of self and our memories of relationships here when we get to heaven? Read I Thessalonians 4:13-18 and see whether Paul seems to agree with this idea.

3. Read Revelation 21:22-22:5. What are the essential needs of humans in this life that God fulfills in the New Jerusalem merely by His presence there?

4. Revelation 21:7 indicates that heaven is granted to those who "overcome". How do we accomplish this challenge in this life—becoming "overcomers"? For help with this read I John 5:4-5, Romans 12:21, and Ephesians 6: 10-13.
