Into the Bible

In our humanness we are all too often quick to take offense when we feel we have been wronged. What does God tell us about this easy anger? (Psalm 37:8, Ecclesiastes 7:9, Proverbs 15:18) How can I behave in a more godly way when provoked to anger? (Psalm 103:8, Exodus 34:6)

Law and liberty seem to be opposites, but Christ's freedom that he has won for us puts us under a new obligation. What limitation is placed on us with his "law of liberty"? (John 8:36, Galatians 5:13-14)

Application

We have heard it said that "talk is cheap", and we know that we must "walk the walk," not merely "talk the talk". How do we demonstrate to a watching world that our faith is genuine? (James 2:14-17, Galatians 6:2, Proverbs 14:31, Matthew 25:40)
